ORDINANCE 2002-1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MCKINLEYVILLE COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT AMENDING THE DISTRICT'S RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT

- WHEREAS, The Board wishes to provide quality parks and recreation services to it's constituents; and
- WHEREAS, The Board wishes to ensure its parks and recreation services are responsive to the needs of its constituents and desires input from the community on such services and issues; and
- WHEREAS, The Board desires input from the community on such services and related-issues; and
- WHEREAS, The Board wishes to ensure access to parks and recreation facilities for members of the community; and
- WHEREAS, The Board desires to provide facilities for public use, special events, and events of community-wide significance;
- WHEREAS, The Board on February 20, 2002 held a duly noticed hearing to consider first reading of this ordinance; and
- WHEREAS, Notice of this hearing was posted and published in accordance with state law and copies of the draft ordinance have been made available for public inspection prior to the February 20, 2002 hearing on this ordinance.
- WHEREAS, The Board on March 20, 2002 held a duly noticed hearing to consider second reading of this ordinance; and
- WHEREAS, Notice of this hearing was posted and published in accordance with state law and copies of the draft ordinance have been made available for public inspection prior to the March 20, 2002 hearing on this ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE MCKINLEYVILLE COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE IV- PARKS AND RECREATION

REGULATION 40.- Recreation and Parks Advisory Committee

Rule 40.01. MEMBERSHIP. The McKinleyville Community Services District Recreation and Parks Advisory Committee shall consist of nine (9) members who shall serve without compensation selected as follows:

- a. One (1) member shall be a member of the District Board.
- b. One (1) member shall be a member of the McKinleyville Area Fund Board of Directors nominated by the McKinleyville Area Fund Board of Directors.
- b. Seven (7) members shall be resident electors of the District representing to the extent possible various recreational interests of the community including but not limited to
